# Year in Review

Thanks to you, our Kasisi children have had yet another **wonderful year**. Even though the number of children has increased, with your support we have been able to provide them with a true Home, care, education, and food. The numbers are impressive – our kitchen has been working at full capacity, preparing **over 27,000 meals per month!**



## Numbers

Over the past year, **259 children** lived at Kasisi, including **52 newcomers**.

**Five children were adopted**, and **38 returned** to live with their families.

# Funds Transferred to Kasisi

In 2023, the value of assistance provided to Kasisi and the foundation's beneficiaries amounted to **€381 510,40.**

Most of the needs of the Kasisi Children's Home were met thanks to the **wonderful support** from the **"Adoptions from the Heart" program – €357 042,10.**

## Investments in Kasisi



### Sports and Play Are Serious Business

We created **two new playrooms**, renovated **two gazebos**, and finalized the construction of **soccer fields**. Both boys and girls are thrilled!



### Babies' Sleeping Rooms Remodeling

We started with a **thorough renovation** and finally **replaced 30** metal, worn-out **cribs** of the youngest children with new, wooden, warm cribs and soft mattresses. Now the rooms look like something out of a fairy tale. This purchase will serve many generations of Kasisi children!



### Safety Matters

We built a **new wall around the Home** – it's not Chinese, but still great. It is effective at ensuring the safety of the entire Children's Home and keeping uninvited guests out. At the House of Mercy, we also installed additional **motion sensors**. All the children at Kasisi can now sleep peacefully.



### Air Conditioners Purchase

Zambian heat can be truly unbearable. We invested in **new air conditioners** to maintain the appropriate temperature in the rooms of the youngest children. Now they can sleep and play without worrying about overheating.

# Education

Thanks to the support of our donors, we were able to provide education for all Kasisi children: those in preschool, school, and college. We financed both the tuition and boarding school. This support also covered the costs of school textbooks and uniforms.

In 2023, the funds we provided supported the education of:

- **56** preschoolers
- **105** primary school students
- **30** high school students
- **11** college students
- **3** university students



## How We Used the Donations

# James Medical Student

James graduated from medical studies at the Collegium Medicum of Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń, finally passing the LEK exam, which summarizes the entire course of study, on his first attempt.

As James is planning a future in neurosurgery, in 2023 **we funded the final stage of his education** – a 6-month internship at a hospital.

We paid for his **tuition**, purchased **textbooks**, and covered James's **basic living expenses**.

# Eva Medical Student


Eva, following in James's footsteps, completed her fifth year of studies at the Collegium Medicum of Nicolaus Copernicus University in Toruń. We financed her **tuition**, purchased **textbooks**, and covered Eva's **basic living expenses**.

Our student, just like James, passes all her exams on the first attempt. She has one more year of hard work ahead of her!



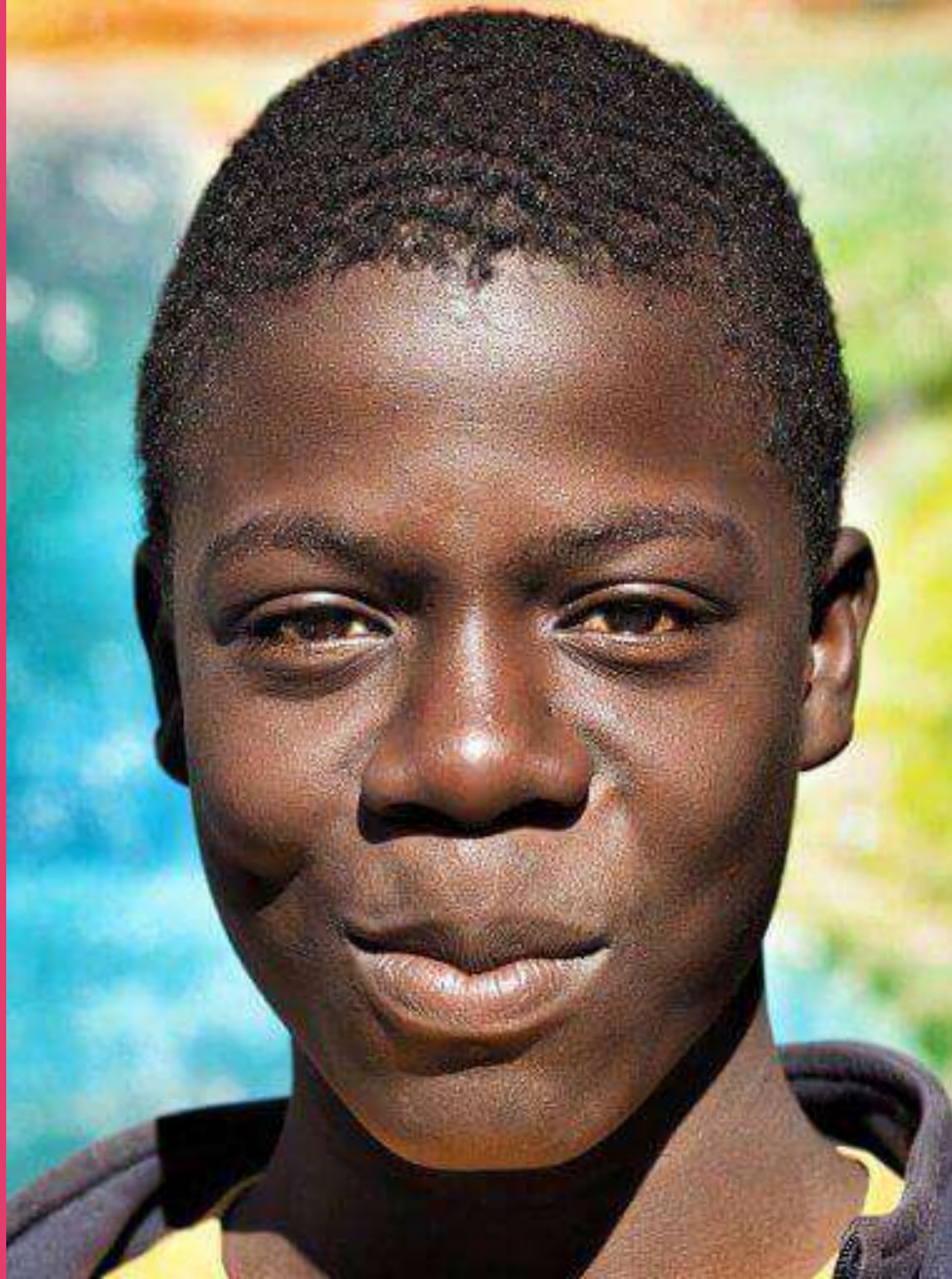

# Christopher Sakala Memorial Fund

Through the Christopher Sakala Memorial Fund, we have **provided care for 18 patients** in the Oncology Department at the hospital in Lusaka. The funds collected allowed us to purchase medications, dressings, food, clothing, toys for children, as well as to cover chemotherapy costs and transportation back home after hospitalization. Additionally, we assisted the families of deceased children with funeral arrangements.

### Who Was Christopher “Krzyś” Sakala

Sister Mariola, who visited Christopher when he was undergoing cancer treatment in the hospital, witnessed very difficult situations. She saw the poverty and suffering of children with cancer, who receive nothing but a bowl of porridge three times a day. Most parents cannot afford treatment. In memory of Krzyś, we established a fund that continues to operate today, supporting the cancer treatment of other children.
